Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for working with us during these recent challenging months. I write in the sincere hope that you and your loved ones are safe and well. That has been our primary concern throughout.

All schools are set to resume in September, with a full pupil complement. As I wrote in an earlier letter to you, some COVID related changes will be necessary. Your Headteacher will have communicated the specific details separately.
